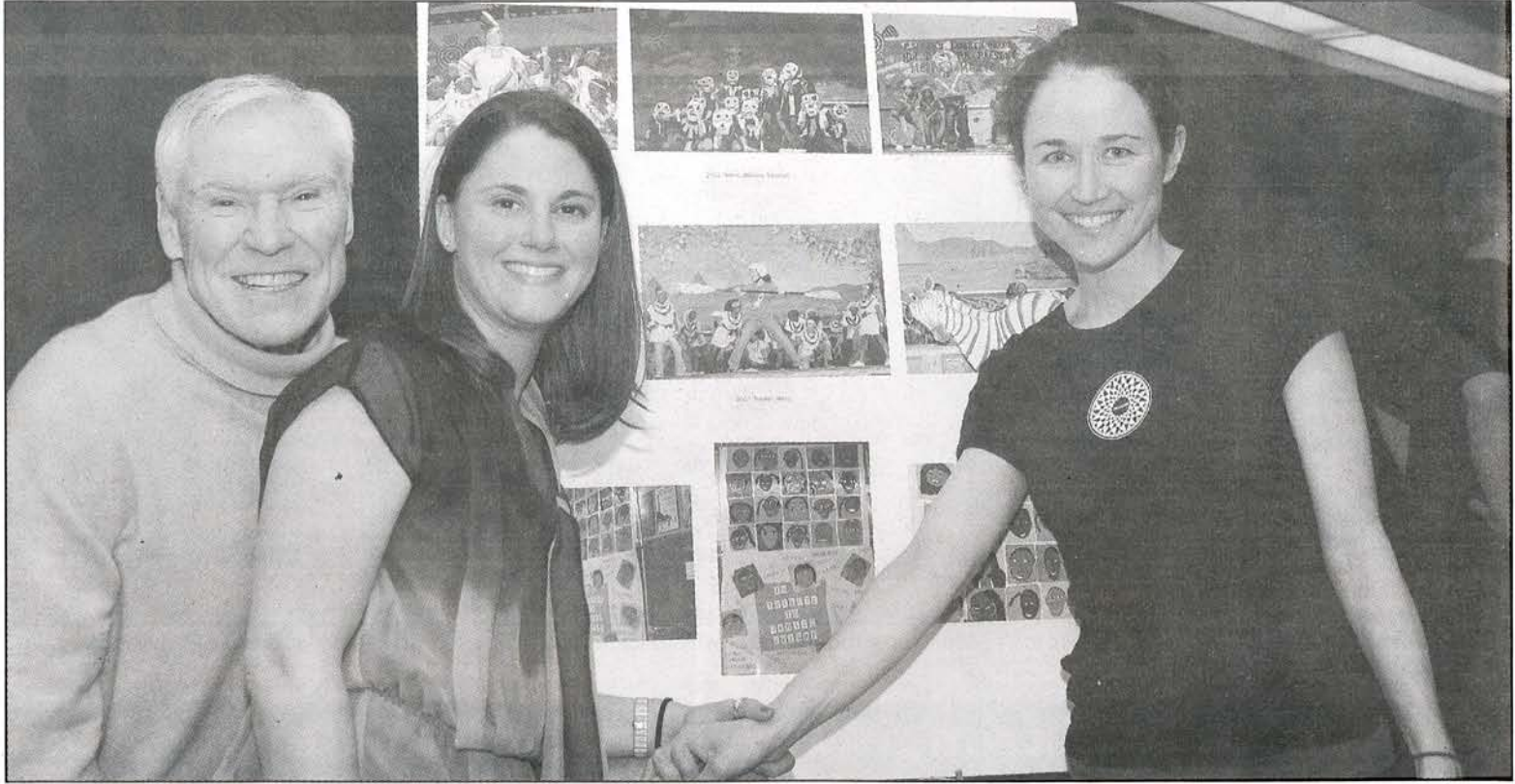


P.S. 235 Teacher Honored By National Dance Institute
